Redevelopment proposal for Dorothy Lloyd Room

Following several discussions and prayerful consideration, the following redevelopment for part of the ground floor of Maxwell Halls is proposed to allow a fresh expression of church life and growth.

Vision

This proposal will re-establish the Dorothy Lloyd Room as a multipurpose area that replaces the disused playgroup room but, more importantly, provide an accessible accommodation for all people, which can be used for activities usually hosted on the first floor of Maxwell Halls. Also, this area has the potential to open out activities to the adjacent patio to help create a clear visible presence in the community. Potential activities include:

1) Church members

A small meeting place for the church family at Maxwell. This includes an area for small group activities such as:

- Prayer prayer meetings, times of personal/pastoral prayer.
- Teaching study groups, discipleship workshops.
- Fellowship social evenings such as small group hospitality (eg men's curry night), craft events (eg jewellery making for Blythswood boxes), Castle Cafe.

2) Outreach

An area in Maxwell that can be used for multipurpose outreach activities so that connections can be developed with people from our community. This would allow Maxwell to serve our local community and build relationships whilst encouraging people to join us periodically for specific church services for evangelism (eg Christmas , Easter, Harvest services). Activities could include the following:

- Community cafe specific groups such as people with dementia, carers and the people they
 care for and parents with young children. A small team of volunteer workers would provide
 practical support along with volunteers who would provide pastoral support and evangelism.
- Outreach activities (Alpha courses could be hosted in this area).
- Themed coffee mornings such as ERGC, Beatson, hospice and Alzheimers association (these could be restricted to Christian charities).

For many years, members of Maxwell have prayed for God's church to flourish and this proposal is a small step towards rebuilding Maxwell. The working group propose a prompt timescale to coincide with the appointment of our new minister, which could be highlighted by a special event at the end of the summer such as a Saturday coffee morning to raise the local profile of the new era of Maxwell.
